Items need to be at curb by 6:00 p.m. Friday May 11. Appliances, televisions, computers, monitors, etc. WILL be collected. Construction materials bundled in 4' lengths of 40 lb. or less WILL be accepted, also.

Do not put the above items in regular trash containers. Regular trash will be picked up Wednesday, May 16 with household waste only.

The following items will NOT be picked up: brush, leaves and other organic material; shingles/roofing materials; hazardous household waste including thinners, herbicides, drain cleaners, brake fluids, chemical bleaches, oven cleaners, oil-based paint, varnishes, propane tanks, motor oils, anti-freeze, tires and batteries; concrete materials.

City personnel will NOT pick up restricted items left on curb. Contact Aspen Waste at 515-974-1400 PRIOR to collection for special requests.
