

ORDINANCE NO. 092022-1

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF  
THE CITY OF HARTFORD, IOWA, 2020, BY AMENDING  
ORDINANCE 35.14 EMERGENCY RESCUE SERVICE.**

**BE IT ENACTED** by the City Council of the City of HARTFORD, Iowa:

**SECTION 1. SECTION MODIFIED.** Chapter 35, Section 14(1) Fees of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Hartford, Iowa is repealed, and the following adopted in lieu thereof:

**35.14 EMERGENCY RESCUE SERVICE.** The department is authorized to provide Emergency rescue services and the accidental injury and liability insurance provided for herein shall include such operation.

**1. Fees.** The following schedule of charges shall be imposed for all EMS calls made by the Hartford Fire Department:

<b>BLS Non-Emergency Base</b>	<b>\$583.00</b>

<b>ALS Non-Emergency Base</b>	<b>\$699.00</b>
<b>ALS Emergency Level 1</b>	<b>\$1,107.00</b>
Billable level when an AEMT is present	
<b>ALS Emergency Level 2</b>	<b>\$1,602.00</b>
Billable level when a Paramedic is present	
<b>Paramedic Tier</b>	<b>\$250.00</b>
<b>Creating Landing Zone</b>	<b>\$500.00</b>
<b>Mileage and Cost</b>	<b>\$21.00 per loaded mile</b>
<b>Death Determination</b>	<b>\$100.00</b>
<b>Private Pay</b>	<b>\$100.00</b>
<b>Private Ambulance Standby</b>	<b>\$150.00 per hour</b>


**SECTION 2. REPEALER.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

**SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE.** If any section, provision, or part of this

ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

**SECTION 4. WHEN EFFECTIVE.** This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its final passage, approval and publication as provided by law.


