

ORDINANCE NO. 121724-1

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF HARTFORD, IOWA, 2019, BY AMENDING ORDINANCE CHAPTER 106.08.02 RECYCLING FEES.

BE IT ENACTED by the City Council of the City of HARTFORD, Iowa:

SECTION 1. Purpose. The Purpose of this amendment is to raise the recycling rate to meet the current charges to the City of Hartford for recycling.

SECTION 2. Section Amended. Section 106.08.02 entitled RECYCLING FEES, which is hereby adopted to read as follows:

Effective July 1, 2025


106.08.02 Recycling Fee. An additional fee of \$4.64 per month shall be charged to each customer receiving the Curb-It Recycling Program service.

SECTION 2. REPEALER. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, provision or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 4. WHEN EFFECTIVE. This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its final passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
